English

Maths

In Maths, we have been learning to add by putting the larger number first, and counting on to find the answer. We have also been beginning to add 1-digit to 2-digit numbers and add to next multiple of 10, by counting on. We have been using lots of resources to help us such as, number lines, 100 squares, bead strings, and cubes. We are continuing to affirm our knowledge of number bonds, and remembering the pattern for how to find them all!

You could:

- Practise singing a counting song for continuing on or backwards. See if you can turn this information into number sentences!
- Practise number formations.
- Practice counting up to 20 and backwards again, making sure all of the numbers are said in the right order.
