Maths

In Maths, we have started a new unit of work based around Measure. We began by testing our knowledge of propositional language, playing games such as 'Hide the Teddy'. We also played group games, where we had to listen to and follow instructions, dictated by our peers. We then moved onto learning about standard and non-standard units of measure, which we will continue to investigate over the coming weeks.
