

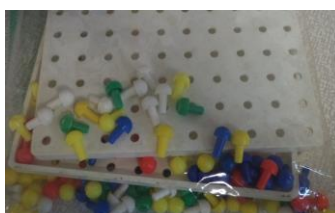
**Alternative methods of recording**

- Coloured overlays and paper/books

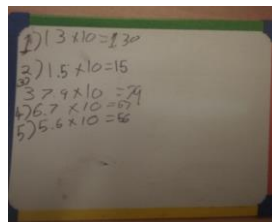
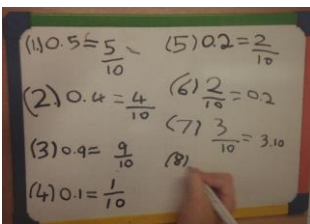


- Paired work/ dictation/ scribing
