1. Team Tutti – www.teamtutti.org This is a sequence of lessons teaching you how to use a music sketchpad online to create your own music. You watch a video which will explain what you do then carry out the activity on the sketchpad. There are also challenges and quizzes to try.
2. BBC Ten Pieces – <https://www.bbc.co.uk/teach/ten-pieces/ten-pieces-at-home/zjy3382> The BBC have created a series of lessons based on their Ten Pieces initiative. Scroll down to start at week one, or pick a lesson you like the look of!
3. Charanga – if you have been given a Charanga login (y1-6) there is a new unit on the website for you to follow. Try and pace your self – don't do it all in one week!
4. Chrome Music Lab - <https://musiclab.chromeexperiments.com/> this is less structured but is a lovely way to explore music. If you select melody maker you can save your work as a link and send it to me to listen to!

I will continue to send you marvellous me's each week to remind you to do your music lesson but it will be up to you to choose which lesson you do. Try to follow the same scheme each week if you can as this will help you to progress your music skills.

I will also continue to award badges for any fantastic examples of work you send me – remember it can be photos, videos or pieces of work. I can't wait to see what you get up to!
